'World Bioethics Day 2020' Theme: Benefit and Harm Karpaga Vinayaga Unit of the UNESCO Chair in Bioethics

The Karpaga Vinayaga Unit of the UNESCO Chair in Bioethics, Karpaga Vinayaga Institute of Medical Sciences and Research Centre celebrated 'World Bioethics Day 2020' on 19th October 2020. The students of Karpaga Vinayaga Educational Group - Karpaga Vinayaga Institute of Medical Sciences and Research Centre (KIMS & RC), Karpaga Vinayaga Institute of Dental Sciences (KIDS) and Karpaga Vinayaga College of Nursing (KVCN) participated in this event. The theme for the year 2020 was Benefit and Harm and all programmes were conducted to highlight the theme among the faculty and students.

Undergraduate Medical, Dental, Nursing and Allied Health Sciences students and Postgraduate students participated in this interdisciplinary event. A total of 777 students participated in this grand event. This interdisciplinary event to celebrate World Bioethics Day 2020 , was conducted successfully in an online platform. The competitive events that were open to the student participants were Speak Bioethics, English Essay Writing, Tamil Essay Writing, English Poetry, Tamil Poetry, Drawing, Debate, Digital art and Slogan competitions, to commemorate World Bioethics Day 2020.

The main competitive event of the day 'Speak Bioethics' had 10 enthusiastic students qualified to participate and spoke on subtopics on the theme of the year, Benefit and Harm. The participants were required to give an extempore speech for three minutes on the allotted topic which was related to Benefit and Harm. The best participants were declared winners by Dr. J. Mahesh, Senior Assistant Professor, Public Health Dentistry, KIDS.

A debate competition was conducted and 6 important ethical dilemmas were debated fiercely by the students on these ethical issues faced during the pandemic. This event was judged by Dr. Arumuganathan, Associate Professor, Department of Psychiatry, KIMS&RC.

The Drawing competition was another event that motivated the students to bring out their creativity and showed their interest in knowing more about bioethics. A total of 55 students each took part in the Drawing competition to display their artistic skills. This was an offline event. This event was judged by Dr. S. Girija, Professor, Department of Anatomy, KIMS&RC.

Essays written by the participants of the Essay Writing competition were inspired by the theme of the year. Participants effectively presented their views on Benefit and Harm in the form of well written essays. The English Essay Writing competition had 52 participants and was judged by Dr. R. Madhumitha, Assistant Professor, Department of Pathology, KIMS&RC. While the Tamil Essay Writing competition had around 30 participants and was judged by Dr. Karthik, Assistant Professor, Department of Pathology, KIMS&RC.
